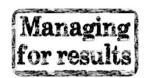
Minimum requirements



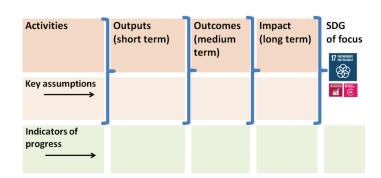


- PROBLEM ANALYSIS
 - **Explore** the root causes of the problem.
- STAKEHOLDER ANALYSIS

 Identify beneficiary needs and other actors providing similar technical assistance.
- VALUE ADDED
 Propose a unique solution that targets one or more of the root causes.
- RESULTS FRAMEWORK (or logical framework)

Link activities to outputs and to medium and long term results.

List assumptions made and indicators to measure progress.



- WORKPLAN
 Establish the sequence of activities and expected duration.
 Plan for contingencies.
 Assign responsibilities.
- BUDGET
 Estimate realistically the project costs.
- 7 MONITORING
 Define the monitoring plan (who does what when).
 Measure and document progress on the indicators.
- EVALUATION

 Answer "what worked well?" and "what could have been done better" using the UN evaluation criteria of relevance, efficiency, effectiveness and sustainability.
- **REPORTING**Report on implementation (quarterly) and on impact (twice a year) to the Division Director and UNCTAD Technical Cooperation Service.
- LESSONS LEARNED

 Discuss lessons learned and reflect them in decision-making and future projects.
