Period of Occupancy

Confirmed rooms will be available for occupancy after 14.00 hours on the day arrival. Check-out time is 12.00 hours. Late checkout is subject to room availability. Rooms used from 12.00 hours to 18.00 hours on the day of departure will be charged at the day used rates, (50 % of agreed room rate). Rooms occupied beyond 18.00 hours will be charged at the full contract rate, unless specified otherwise in writing by The Hotel.

FIELD TRIP

A one day ITF field trip to organic farms and facilities plus cultural sites, is scheduled on Friday, 29 November. More information on the tour will be provided in October along with the final meeting documents. The trip is kindly hosted by Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Indonesia.

MEALS

Four lunches and three dinners are hosted by the Ministry of Agriculture (see agenda for details). All other meals are at participant's responsibility. There will be more information about meals in the introduction sessions of the workshop.

PASSPORT & VISA

All foreigners wishing to enter Indonesia must have a passport valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of arrival along with the proof (tickets) of onward or return passage.

Free Tourist Visa

The immigration authorities provide free tourist visa for period of 30 days to nationals of 11 countries: Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei Darussalam, the Philippines, Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR), Macao SAR, Chili, Morocco, Peru and Vietnam.

Visa on Arrival

Visa on arrival is given to nationals from 21 countries: Australia, Argentina, Brazil, Denmark, Canada, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, Italy, Japan, Norway, Poland, South Africa, South Korea, Switzerland, New Zealand & Taiwan, the United Arab Emirate, and the United States of America.

The visa on arrival fee are classified into two: USD 10 for maximum 3 days visit and USD 30 for maximum stay of 30 days.

TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT

Transportation from the airport to the hotel on your day of arrival and back to the airport on your day of departure will be provided. Please make sure that you inform us when registering for the meeting about the date, exact time and flight number of your arrival and departure.

AIRLINE

For efficiency, we recommend using the airline that have direct flight (connection flight) to Bali.

CLIMATE

Bali is distinctly tropical. The late November weather in Bali is usually warm and humid with temperatures ranging 24 – 30 C and the relative humidity is about 88%.

LANGUAGE

Bahasa Indonesia is the national language, but English is widely spoken in Bali.

CURRENCY

Indonesian currency is Rupiah, which is acceptable at regular stores and restaurants, but most hotels, restaurant and souvenirs shop accept certain foreign currencies and credit cards. The Indonesian Rupiah is available in note denominations of 100,000, 50,000, 20,000, 10,000, 5,000, and 1,000. Coins are available in denomination of 1,000, 500, 200, 100, and 50. You can buy Rupiah at foreign exchange banks and other authorized moneychangers on presentation of your passport. The exchange rate fluctuates regularly. Current exchange rate: USD 1 = 9,050 Rupiah.

ELECTRIC CURRENT

The electric current in use throughout Indonesia is 220 volt at 50 cycles.
